Formerly a single-storey terrace-style workers' cottage dating back to around 1890, the home is now a modern three-storey, three-bedroom family home that has retained and respected the original façade.



The entry opens to a bright, lar open-plan kitchen, dining and living rothat meld — via three-metre-high floto-ceiling sliding doors and generouproportioned louvre windows — to timber deck, wall-hung outdoor kitchen a six-metre-long heated swimming pool.

The basement houses a rumpus/me room, storage space, WC and large laund Four large motorised skylights above stairwell and high-level louvre windows the upper level ensure the home is ligand well ventilated.
